

Instructions for Candidates Applying through CUET (UG)-2026 at Dr. Rammanohar Lohia Avadh University, Ayodhya

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has declared the CUET (UG)-2026 results on 23 June 2026. Candidates seeking admission to Undergraduate Programmes at Dr. Rammanohar Lohia Avadh University, Ayodhya through CUET (UG)-2026 are advised to follow the instructions given below carefully.

- 1. Download and Verify Your CUET Score Card**
 - Download the CUET (UG)-2026 Score Card from the official NTA portal.
 - Verify your personal details, application number, subject-wise scores, and percentile before proceeding with admission.
- 2. Complete Registration on the University Admission Portal**
 - Candidates must register online on the RMLAU Admission Portal if not already registered.
 - Mere appearance in CUET (UG)-2026 does not guarantee admission.
- 3. Update CUET Details Carefully**
 - Enter the CUET Application Number and relevant score details exactly as mentioned in the score card.
 - Any discrepancy in information may lead to cancellation of candidature.
- 4. Verify Eligibility for the Desired Programme**
 - Candidates should ensure that they fulfill the eligibility conditions and subject requirements prescribed for the programme to which admission is sought.
- 5. Upload Required Documents**
 - CUET (UG)-2026 Score Card
 - Class X Mark Sheet and Certificate
 - Class XII Mark Sheet and Certificate
 - Recent Passport Size Photograph
 - Signature
 - Category/EWS/PwD Certificate (if applicable)
 - Other relevant documents as prescribed by the University
- 6. Programme Preference Selection**
 - Candidates should carefully select and lock their programme preferences on the admission portal before the stipulated deadline.
 - Once submitted, preferences may not be modified after the closing date.
- 7. Merit List and Counselling**
 - Merit lists will be prepared by the University based on CUET (UG)-2026 scores, eligibility criteria, reservation policy, and availability of seats.
 - Candidates must regularly check the admission portal for counselling and seat-allotment notifications.
- 8. Document Verification**
 - Admission shall remain provisional until verification of original documents.
 - Submission of false information or invalid certificates will result in cancellation of admission.
- 9. Fee Payment**
 - Candidates allotted seats must pay the prescribed admission fee within the stipulated period to confirm admission.
 - Failure to do so may result in cancellation of the allotted seat.
- 10. Regularly Visit Official Websites**

- Candidates are advised to visit the University Admission Portal and the University website regularly for updates regarding merit lists, counselling schedules, seat allotment, and admission notifications.

Important Note

Since the **CUET (UG)-2026 result has already been declared**, all eligible candidates are advised to complete the admission formalities on the University Admission Portal well before the last date to avoid last-minute technical issues. Admissions shall be made strictly on the basis of merit, eligibility conditions, reservation rules, and seat availability. ([CUET](#))
