About the University

The government of Uttar Pradesh, establish Avadh University, Ayodhya, initially as an affiliating university by its notification No. 1192/fifteen-10-46(6)-1975 dated 04 March, 1975 and appointed Prof. (Dr.) Surendra Singh as the First Vice Chancellor. In 1993-94, it was renamed as Dr. Rammanohar Lohia Avadh University, Ayodhya in the memorial of laded Dr. Rammanohar Lohia, an epic socio-economic ideologue and freedom fighter par excellence. The university initially started its office in a rental building at Civil lines, Ayodhya. Land acquisition process for varsity's formal office started in 1976. Ultimately, the then chancellor and the Governor of State Shri G.D. Tapase laid foundation of the present administrative building of the varsity on 02 May 1978. The university assumed the shape of an affiliating cum residential varsity in April 1984. The residential segment became functional with the opening of four PG departments in the campus viz. History, Culture & Archaeology, Economics & Rural Development. Mathematics & Statistics and Physics & Electronics. Four more departments viz, M.B.A., Bio-Chemistry, Microbiology and Environmental Science were added to its academic paraphernalia in 1993-94 which in -turn brought recognition of the varsity under 12B scheme of U.G.C. With B.Tech. (in Mechanical Engineering, Information technology, Computer Sciences and Electronics & Communication Engineering) and M.C.A. courses. In the same year, some other courses like M.C.J., M.S.W., B.Lib. and M.Lib. Were also added to widen the academic spectrum of the residential setup. In addition, number of PG programs like M.Sc.-Biotechnology, M.T.A.,M.P.Ed., Med. And UG Progrms like B.B.A., B.C.A. and B.P.Ed. Become functional on the campus from the session 2005-06. University started five new courses in campus from session 2027-18. Presently, the university is catering education to about 5 lakhs regular/ private student through its nine residential PG department and on campus Institute of Engineering along -with more than 600 affiliated and on colleges spread over in the 7 district of Ayodhya, Sultanpur, Ambedkar nagar, Lucknow, Barabanki, Baharaich and Gonda.

About the Central Library

The "Central Library" of Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University was established in 1985 with Dr. K.K. Singh as the in-charge of library and Shri S. K. Singh as the cataloguer. During that time only four regular departments were established viz., Physics & Electronics, History, Culture & Archaeology, Mathematics & Statistics and Economics & Rural Development. Around 4000 books related to these courses were purchased. In 1994, 12(b) recognition by University Grants Commission, four more departments offering specialized courses came into existence. These courses included Biochemistry, Microbiology, Environmental Sciences and Management which were research oriented. Thus, with the increase in the number of departments to eight, test books, reference books, periodicals, journals and other relevant compilations increased significantly in the library. In 2001, the central library came up with an independent building and Dr. R.K. Singh was appointed as a regular librarian. The introduction of Institute of Engineering and Technology and other self- finance courses gave further boost to the enhancement of library both in terms of infrastructure and reading materials. With the establishment of "Computer Lab" the Central Library of this university got a special recognition to be the first in the state of Uttar Pradesh where e-journals could be accessed online. At present, the library hosts about 1, 60,000 different titles on myriad subjects. Well equipped with Wi-Fi facility, the library is undergoing tremendous reformation at various levels. Digitization and automation is the key towards making the library at par with any renowned library of the country. This upgraded and modernized "Central Library" will serve as a boon for the seekers of knowledge and information.

Workshop Objectives

1. Comprehensive Training on Open Access Publishing:

Fundamental Principles and Practices: Provide in-depth training on the core principles of open access publishing, including its history, evolution, and current trends. **UNESCO Values and Principles of Open Science:** Explore how open access aligns with UNESCO's Values and Principles of Open Science, promoting transparency, inclusivity, and equity in the global research landscape.

2. Familiarization with Open Access Models and Ethical Standards:

Diverse Open Access Models: Introduce participants to various open access models—Gold, Green, and Hybrid—highlighting the benefits and challenges of each. **Open Public Licensing:** Discuss the importance of open public licensing, with a focus on Creative Commons licenses, ensuring participants understand how to protect their work while promoting accessibility. **Resources for Ethical Publishing:** Guide participants through the use of critical resources like the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), emphasizing ethical standards and best practices in open access publishing.

3. Effective Utilization of Open Publishing Platforms:

Open Journal System (OJS): Provide hands-on training in using OJS (Open Journal System), covering the entire workflow from installation and journal setup to submission management, peer review, and content publication. **Practical Exercises:** Engage participants in practical exercises to reinforce their understanding of OJS, ensuring they can confidently manage an open access journal.

4. Integration of ORCID for Enhanced Researcher Visibility:

Understanding ORCID: Offer a comprehensive overview of ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID), explaining its significance in the academic ecosystem for maintaining accurate and consistent researcher profiles. **ORCID API Integration with OJS:** Demonstrate the integration of the ORCID API with OJS, enabling participants to streamline author identification and improve the accuracy of research attribution.

5. Promoting Global Collaboration and Innovation:

Networking and Collaboration Opportunities: Foster an environment that encourages networking and collaboration among participants, enabling.
